Silicon NPN epitaxial planer type darlington

For low-frequency output amplification

Features

- Forward current transfer ratio h_{FE} is designed high, which is appropriate to the driver circuit of motors and printer bammer: $h_{FE} = 4000$ to 2000 .
- A shunt resistor is omitted from the driver.
- Mini Power type package, allowing downsizing of the equipment and automatic insertion through the tape packing and the magazine packing.
